



## Summary

Total candidates who registered and sat for KCPE-2013 were 340 boys and 381 girls totaling to 721 candidates. Some candidates after enrolling didn't sit for the final exams.

-The data besides shows that **10.88%** of the boys failed to attain the pass mark of 200 as compared to **14.69%** of the girls.  
 -Similarly, **66.47%** of the boys managed to score above 250 marks while **59.31%** of the girls passed by 250 marks and above.  
 -The results also shows that the performance of girls is still low as compared to that of boys. Therefore more efforts should be put by the teachers, parents, pupils and all stakeholders to support the education of the girl child.  
 -In terms of enrollment, more girls (52.84%) enrolled for KCPE 2013 than boys (47.16%) as compared to the previous years. Thanks to tireless efforts put by SBNN to support the education of the girl child within the division. This was done through the open days where educating the girl child took the centre stage. Also the SBNN 10 standards specifically gives education of the girl child a priority.
